CURRENT WORK

Since 2020, we have invested over £6M in energy efficiency measures such as LED lighting and £3.3M in renewable energy projects. We also plan to plant over 90,000 trees by 2025, with 16,000 planted already.

HOW YOU CAN HELP?

Most of AUs' CO₂ emissions come from heating, electricity usage and travel. The following list of actions can help to reduce our environmental impacts:

- 1 Check your radiators for obstructions and that they good airflow
- 2 Turn radiators down when you're not around
- 3 Keep your windows shut when the heating is on
- 4 Only boil the amount of water you need
- 5 Switch off lights & appliances when not in use
- 6 Use a lid on saucepans
- 7 Put full loads in the washing machine
- 8 Take shorter showers to save water
- 9 Use public transport, walk or cycle instead of driving
- 10 Unplug devices when not in use
